Lending conditions for material storage units at Lund University Library

- These lending conditions apply to all loans of material storage in the form of lockers and trolleys at Lund University Library (referred to below as 'the library'). A binding lending agreement applies as of the moment the borrower checks out the key to the locker and/or trolley at the library.
- Only holders of a valid library card may borrow lockers and trolleys at the library.
- Lockers and trolleys are primarily loaned to borrowers of reading room only material at the library.
- Through the loan agreement, the borrower accepts responsibility for the key. The borrower is prohibited from lending the key to any unauthorised person or replacing the lock on the locker and/or trolley. Making copies of keys is not permitted.
- If the key is lost, the borrower will be charged the cost of changing the lock as well as a handling fee.
- The borrower is responsible for the material kept in the locker and/or trolley.
- The library retains the right to open all lockers and trolleys with a master key as needed and without warning.
- The library is not responsible for any personal belongings kept in the locker and/or trolley.
- Only researchers are entitled to borrow lockers and/or trolleys in the scholars' reading rooms Scriptoriet or Collinska rummet. These items have a loan period of 12 months with the possibility of extension, and a fee. Borrowers wishing to renew a loan must do so at the information desk by the end of the loan period. - All lockers and trolleys with a loan period of 6 months are accessible to all borrowers and are free of charge. Extensions of the loan period are not permitted for these lockers and trolleys.
- If the borrower fails to return the key at the end of the loan period, or to renew the loan where possible, the borrower will be charged the handling fee as well as the cost of changing the lock as needed.
- The library retains the right to change all or parts of the present conditions during the period in which the borrower is in possession of the locker and/or trolley without prior notice. The current version of these lending conditions is available on the library's website (www.ub.lu.se).
